How Can Parents Help?

It is the primary responsibility of the parent to guide your child in memorizing their work. (*Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Deut. 11:18-19*) Therefore, we encourage parents to work with their child at home to ensure that your child understands each verse.

PARENTS: Jesus describes heaven as, "my Father's house." He also says He is preparing a place. An inviting picture is conjured in the minds of children as they imagine the Father, the "house" the "rooms", and Jesus' preparation. This passage builds on the truth that God desires to be with His people. Jesus teaches that He is the way to the Father. Jesus' importance is reinforced in children's minds as He reveals that He is the way, the truth, and the life. This is intentionally a recurring theme of this memory plan.

GOD IS EVERYWHERE I AM

PARENTS: One of the earliest questions children ask about God is, "Why can't I see Him?" This verse provides an answer, at least in part, by teaching children that God is Spirit. "Is God always with me?" is another common question asked by boys and girls. This passage presents the truth that God is everywhere present at the same time (omnipresent). Equipping children's hearts with these two truths about God is a huge benefit to them. Children can take great comfort that no matter where they are, they are never alone. Though they cannot see Him, they can rest knowing God is everywhere they are. This passage reinforces personal security and the accessibility of God.

PARENTS: Children are accustomed to asking. This passage capitalizes on that introducing a spiritually truth and a glimpse into the goodness of God. This will be a favorite memory verse for children as it's full of promise and has easy imagery. This passage builds on the understanding of the Father in heaven and presents an open-door policy to Him. The Father's goodness is reinforced further as He is shown as being approachable and welcoming.
